Phase 1	Task	<p><i>The students are divided into 4 expert groups of 4 persons per group and will be asked to read a scientific paper of the PPT Model on the four dimensions of cultural competence provided by the teacher. Gamification		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - <i>Quiz to self-assess their knowledge on cultural competence and correct understanding of the article contents</i> - <i>Level up courses (through gaining points and badges) as students pass the online quiz and final points on the quality of final presentation.</i>
