<b>Phase 1</b>	<b>Task</b>	<i>All the participants have to prepare document about the existing working conditions in the community and the motivation strategies that should be applied both in workers and nurses willed to work in the community. The document should be up to 3.000 words and it can be prepared by 1 or 2 persons.</i>

<b>Phase 2</b>	<b>Task</b>	<p><i>The participants will be asked to propose a solution to a problem related to a planned organizational change. They must prepare a full change program. They are going to work in small groups of 4-5 persons on an issue chosen by their own, but they must cover the roles of the team leader, the programmer of a change program, the organizer, the executive of a change program and the supporter of change.</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ <i>What kind of task are you planning to propose to your students? <b>Phase 3.</b>	<b>Task</b>	<p>The participants must prepare document about the Health management strategies and the nursing care systems applied in the community. Supporting environments for workers in the community must be mentioned. The document should be up to 3.000 words and it can be prepared by 1 or 2 persons.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>What kind of task are you planning to propose to your students? 	<b>Self-regulated learning</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Consume behaviours: Students will be given slide presentations, lecture notes, journals or books for studying.</li> <li>Create behaviours: By writing documents, finding materials and proposing ways of solving a problem</li> <li>Contribute behaviours: Working in groups, sharing their achievements.</li> <li>Connect behaviours: Using the forum and debating with the other students.</li> <li>Main object will be the activation of the students' prior knowledge by working in groups and to build new knowledge on the already existed one.</li> </ul>



<b>Gamification</b>	<p><i>&lt;describe what game elements you are going to embed in your activity to foster students' engagement. You can use the following questions as a stimulus to provide more details:&gt;</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <i>Are you going to use Nurse Sally's bag? How?</i></li> <li>• <i>Are you going to use any game mechanics in your activity (for example levels, badges, point systems, time constraints)?</i></li> <li>• <i>Are you going to use any game feature (such as for example competition, collaboration, exploration and storytelling)?</i></li> </ul> <p><i>I am going to grow the competition between small groups. They are going to share their documents related to the solving problem of a planned change. Then they will compare the achievements between the groups and score them. The goal is that the final score will come out taking into account the scores of the teams but, the purpose is all to get in touch with the work and the opinion of the others.</i></p>
